Honor Flight™ is a network of volunteers established for the express purpose of getting as many WWII Veterans as possible to Washington, DC to view the World War II Memorial. Honor Flight™ was originally set up in 2004 by Earl Morse, a physician's assistant from Ohio. Honor Flight™ DFW (HFDFW) was established in September 2008 to bring this wonderful effort to the Dallas/Ft Worth/North Texas area. To date, Honor Flight DFW has flown over 600 WWII veterans to Washington, DC. The organization is currently accepting applications from both WW2 AND Korean war veterans.

Sherry W5YUP called the meeting to order and asked the attendees to introduce themselves by name and call sign.

The minutes for the November meetings were submitted for publication in the January 2014 newsletter. A motion was made and carried to accept the minutes as published.

Joyce W5FJB reviewed the financial report for November and December 2013. A motion was made and carried to accept for audit the financial reports as published.

A break was taken at 8:05pm.
