Meeting Minutes

August 2022 Membership Meeting Minutes submitted by Andy Kapushoc KB2VQA, Secretary

The regular meeting of the membership of the AARC was called to order on August 19th, 2022, at 7:30 pm by the President, Jack AA5VZ, accompanied by a teleconference simulcast. Other board members present included Vice President, Philip KD5WBW; Secretary, Andy KB2VQA; Treasurer and Repeater Trustee, Maurice KM5RF; Training Coordinator and Agent of Record, Phil N5PWW; and Editor, Trey AF5XS. Absent was Emergency Coordinator, Bill AE5BT.

Jack AA5VZ called the meeting to order, and asked attendees to introduce themselves by name and call sign. After introductions, the attendees served themselves ice cream.

Jack AA5VZ thanked Philip KD5WBW for presenting at last month's meeting on the topic of DMR (Digital Mobile Radio). The monthly siren test was conducted in August, and sirens are available for those who would like to participate in the test. Jack will work on providing the Irving ARC with a letter of confirmation that the micro-grant funds were used to purchase the new electrical generator that was used during Field Day. Jack informed the attendees of the Winter Field Day event held on January 28-29, 2023, which is not a contest, to determine if they would like to plan on participating.

Philip KD5WDW mentioned that in addition to the ice cream social, the evening would include a show-and-tell.

Andy KB2VQA noted that the August newsletter contained the minutes from the July meetings. A motion was made and carried to accept the minutes as published.

Maurice KM5RF reviewed the financial report of July 2022. Phil N5PWW successfully closed the certificate of deposit. A motion was made and carried to accept the report for audit as published. Maurice plans to visit the repeater site during the month of October.

Trey AF5XS compiled and distributed the newsletter for August 2022. All submissions are welcomed and requested to be received by the Saturday before the club meeting.

Phil N5PWW continues to hold testing sessions promptly at 10 am on the first and third Saturdays of the month at 401 W. Sanford Street (use the entrance on the north side). An FRN is required prior to taking an exam. In the future, classes will take place in the Sanford Street building.

Bill AE5BT was not present, however Jack passed along the information that Field Day 2023 was 309 days away.

Old business: No old business was presented. New business: No new business was presented.

The show-and-tell started at 8:20 pm.

The meeting adjourned at 9:40 pm. The sign-in sheet showed 23 people in attendance, 19 indicating AARC membership. Zoom attendees numbered 1.
